PLEASE EMPTY AND RINSE ALL CONTAINERS

<u>MATERIAL</u>	<u>RECYCLE THESE</u>	<u>NOT ACCEPTABLE</u>
GLASS	All glass bottles, and jars clear, green and brown	NO mirror or window glass NO light bulbs NO drinking glasses or cups NO plates or ceramics NO broken bottles or jars
CANS	All aluminum and steel food and beverage cans aluminum foil products	NO pots, pans, tubing or furniture NO siding NO foil gift wrap NO automotive parts
PLASTIC	All clear or colored plastic bottles. Margarine & yogurt containers Clear "salad bar" containers	NO containers which have contained hazardous materials such as motor oil, antifreeze or lawn and garden chemicals. NO Styrofoam or plastic wrap
MIXED PAPER	Newspapers, magazines Catalogs, phone books Office & computer paper Newspaper inserts Unwanted mail, Paperback books	NO packing material (foam/plastic) NO food soiled paper or plastic NO wax coated liners NO wax paper, carbon paper NO paint contaminated paper NO hardback books
CARDBOARD	Corrugated cardboard* Cereal and other boxes	NO PIZZA BOXES NO food soiled cardboard

*Flatten all empty boxes; tie in bundles no larger than 3' x 3' and no thicker than 6" each. Acceptable materials can be combined together and placed in paper bags or small cardboard boxes.

YARD WASTE (Picked up by our Trash Contractor)

BAG IT

Place leaves, grass, brush and other yard trimmings in the large brown paper bags available at local grocery, hardware and/or home improvement stores.

CAN IT

Use reusable containers, such as trash cans. Cans must be marked "recycling". Bright green stickers are available in the Town Office.

BUNDLE IT

Brush can be tied into bundles no larger than 30" in diameter, 4' in length. Pieces may not exceed 4" in diameter.
